




Offer young people and women the keys to the digital world through 4 major digital education programs, in France, Europe, Africa and the Middle East.

By training them in digital makers workshops of the FabLab network. Training is based on the «do it yourself» concept, collaborative creation and the use of digital tools: 3D printers, digital milling machines, digital cutters...


Our ambition:
